(The second part of reflections on our Parish Church)

Dear Friends,

Some things can be old fashioned, but Catholic Tradition is never outdated; the meaning of the word is to 'hand on' all that is good and holy. This is God's revelation, which is found both in Scripture and Tradition, handed on by the Apostles, in all purity, for every generation in continuity and not in rupture. As Cardinal Francis Arinze famously said, 'if you can find any document from Rome saying, "remove the altar rails", I will give you a turkey'.

Tradition speaks to those outside the Church too. People, that are hurt by the world, often take refuge in a Church building as it speaks without speaking to show the Truth. Tradition is Christ's own teaching to His Apostles and as St Paul reminds the Corinthians, "For I received from the Lord what I also handed on to you". The Church, is the icon of Christ's presence, accomplishes the work of our salvation. The blood and water from His side, found in the sacraments, is a living river bringing us to communion with the Blessed Trinity. And, so Cardinal Arinze said of those wishing to receive Holy Communion on the tongue, 'you leave them in peace - and not in pieces.'

We've been granted the pledge of eternal life, a reality that begins here and now. We would all be happy, as others have also asked, if we can improve the state of the church. Here is a list of items that requires sorting out and fixing: the roof, the sky lights and the outside walls and then we can start on the interior of the Church, the Sacristies and the Narthex all need painting, the floors need restoring, a new white simple ceiling needs to be installed including new church lighting. It would make the church even more beautiful. We need help to do this and I hope we can achieve this for the benefit of our community and for the Glory of God here in Knaphill. We will talk more about this in the Autumn.

And so, "May the heart of Jesus, in the Most Blessed Sacrament, be praised, adored, and loved with grateful affection, at every moment, in all the tabernacles of the world, even to the end of time."
