Next Saturday we celebrate the 42nd Anniversary of the Consecration of our Church by the then Bishop Cormac. The solemn dedication of a Church is a moment of spiritual joy for all God's people of the Parish. The building is not only about the chief achievement of the people who worked hard in building and paying for it. It makes the very simple fact that God dwells amongst his people in Knaphill. 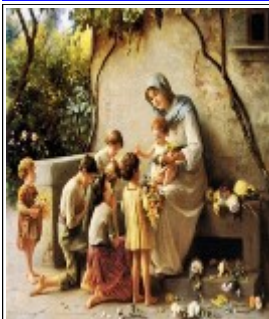
