Seventh Sunday of Easter - 24th May 2020

If you look around the walls of any consecrated Catholic Church you will see twelve candles and close to them twelve stones or crosses set into the walls. These and the Altar were solemnly anointed with Sacred Chrism and the candles first lit when the Church was consecrated for use as a place where God is worshipped. The candles are lit on the 23rd of May each year when the Church celebrates the Anniversary of the Dedication.

Why twelve candles and twelve stones? Quite simply, because there were twelve apostles. When we say the Creed, we confess that “We believe in one holy, catholic and apostolic Church.” Our faith is “apostolic” because it is based on the teachings of Jesus, carried on by the apostles, the direct successors of whom are our bishops, guided by the Holy Spirit. The consecration candles, can be up to twelve in number representing the twelve apostles; we have four as this is also allowed. We can’t get into our house of prayer at the moment but we still know the effect of Christ presented in the tabernacle.

“We now anoint this altar and this building. May God in his power make them holy, visible signs of the mystery of Christ and His Church.”
(Prayer used at the anointing).
