Dear Friends,

We approach the time when we would be having our First Holy Communion Masses and celebrations, which is so appropriate for the beautiful month of June dedicated to the Sacred Heart after the Easter season and Our Lady's month of May. It's sad not to have our children make their Communions now with their parents, family members, friends and our community, but we hope and trust it will be soon. Also, I thought that we would be back by now, but sadly we have to be wise and wait.

I received a letter from Bishop Richard late on Friday afternoon with plans for the reopening of the Church for prayer as soon as the Government allows it. He wants us to have our strategy in place so we can smoothly go into reopening when we are allowed. Of course this does mean that Public Masses and Devotions are still a way off. Just to reopen the Church will mean a task force of people from our Parish, who are not vulnerable or around vulnerable people, to volunteer to maintain the necessary hygiene and cleaning routines so people can be allowed in; I can't do that by myself. On behalf of the Parish community, I can't thank you enough and the benefit of this will ensure that this established cleaning routine will make it easier for when we are allowed to have public liturgies again.

It seems that we could manage the Church being opened for a few hours a day if we have tape, hand gel and sanitisers, but we probably might need some more cleaning things in order to do this. It's been tough as your Priest to close the Church door behind me as I'm not allowed to let people in; it's a house of prayer, our beacon of light and our home to sing Him praises. People have said how lucky I am to have the Blessed Sacrament, to be in his presence and receive Him. The Body of Christ and his awesome presence in my midst is not the same without you, the Body of Christ.

Please join me in praying the Litany of the Sacred Heart at our Evening Devotions on Facebook or privately. On Tuesday the 16th we will have a Zoom meeting to talk about the Sacred Heart in scripture, about St Margaret bringing this devotion to the world and how we can grow as a friend of Christ the Sacred Heart.
