### **Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles - 28th June 2020**

On the Solemnity of St Peter and St Paul we remember their symbols: the keys and a sword. The keys remind us of when Jesus gave St Peter the keys "of the kingdom of heaven" and the sword reminds us of St Paul who speaks of the "sword of the Spirit", which is "the Word of God". The Apostles Peter and Paul were martyred in Rome in the year 67 AD. St Peter was crucified upside down in the circus of Nero. St Paul, a Roman citizen, perished by the sword. The Church was founded on the faith of these two Apostles, we seek strength to be the Church, which Our Lord founded. "On this rock I will build my Church". We desire to be faithful to Christ who was broken for us on Calvary and who continues to be offered in the Holy Mass.

With that note I am delighted to share that we are able to offer public Mass from next weekend. Before we talk about the times, we must be very clear that life is extremely different since COVID-19 and lockdown. The things that we are so used to will be different and that is not in my power to change. I too have to submit to this guidance to ensure the health and well-being of you and me. Also, some people will not be able to come back to Holy Mass here just yet, we need to imply the virtue of patience. You will need to book in to come to Mass and we are only allowed 16 places in the Church; just to make it simpler a family or a couple makes that one place. So please email (knaphill@abdiocese.org.uk) your preferred choice to the Parish Office by 6.00pm on the Friday evening.

The Church will be open 15 minutes before the start of Holy Mass. The Mass will be different. You will sign in and then be led to your seat. You don't need to wear a mask at the moment because of the 2 metre rule, but if you feel uncomfortable then you must wear your own mask. There will be no toilets, no coffee and tea. Expect no music, a very short homily (thank the Lord), no bidding prayers, no Sign of Peace and Holy Communion will be after the Final Blessing, to which we would normally say 'Amen,' but from now until we are told, we receive the Lord in silence. We will then depart from the Church via the side door straight after receiving the Sacred Host.

## Church Opening - Private Prayer - Tuesdays 2.00pm to 4.00pm

We received from Bishop Richard guidelines as to what had to be done in each parish before our Church could be opened. As requested, we completed a risk assessment and sent it to the Diocese for approval, which we have now received.

It is essential that all visiting the Church adhere to the following rules/guidelines:

- ✦ *Enter the Church by the main door*
- ✦ *If capacity is reached, you may be asked to wait*
- ✦ *Please use the sanitiser provided as you enter the Church*
- ✦ *Please maintain a distance of 2 metres/6 feet apart at all times*
- ✦ *You will be asked for your name and contact number in case of need*
- ✦ *If you wish to light a candle, ask the Steward as you enter and you will be given one.  
A donation would be very welcome*
- ✦ *Please note your votive candle should be lit on your way out*
- ✦ *Please sit alone where indicated in the Church unless you belong to the same household*
- ✦ *Please do not touch any statues, crucifixes or shrines*
- ✦ *Toilets will not be available*
- ✦ *If you wish to wear a face covering, please do so*
- ✦ *Unaccompanied children cannot be allowed in*
- ✦ *Access to the Sacristy and Narthex will not be allowed*
- ✦ *Exit by Our Lady's altar only*
- ✦ *Please use the sanitiser provided as you exit the Church*

These guidelines will be displayed on the noticeboard.

Stewards will be available to assist and guide you.
