### The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary 16th August 2020



Here is an excerpt from a Sermon given by St Anthony of Padua on the mystery of the Assumption. He uses the powerful words from Isaiah 61:13 "I will glorify the place of my feet". We have a clear statement that the Blessed Virgin has been assumed in her body, to the place by the Lord's feet. Hence it is the holy Psalmist that writes "arise, O Lord, into your resting place: you and the ark which you have sanctified and that she has risen up, since on this day the Virgin Mother has been taken up to her heavenly dwelling."(Psalm 132) (*Sermones Dominicales et in Solemnitatibus, In Assumptione S. Mariae Virginis Sermo.*):

## CHURCH OPENING

**In line with the guidance, face coverings should be worn whilst in the Church.**

Private Prayer : Tuesdays 2.00pm - 3.00pm

**NB: Tuesday 18th August, only Private Adoration from 2.00pm - 3.00pm, no Public Mass**

Public Mass : Fridays 6.00pm; Sunday Mass - 8.00am, 10.00am & 5.00pm

Here are the Guidelines when visiting the Church.

It is essential that all kindly adhere to the following:

### General guidelines for all services:

- Enter the Church by the main door
- If capacity is reached, you may be asked to wait
- Please use the sanitiser provided as you enter the Church
- Please maintain a distance of 2 metres/6 feet apart at all times
- You will be asked for your name and contact number in case of need
- If you wish to light a candle, ask the Steward as you enter and you will be given one (Candles are only available at private prayer)
- Please note your votive candle should be lit on your way out
- Please sit alone where indicated in the Church unless you belong to the same household
- Please do not touch any statues, crucifixes or shrines
- Access to the Sacristy and Narthex will not be allowed, toilets will not be available
- If you wish to wear a face covering, please do so
- Exit by Our Lady's altar only and please use the sanitiser provided as you exit.

### Additional guidelines for Mass:

- ◆ Please book your place by emailing the Parish Office at [knaphill@abdiocese.org.uk](mailto:knaphill@abdiocese.org.uk) stating your preferred time of Mass; you will receive an email confirming your place.
- ◆ Deadline for booking will be 6.00pm on the Friday evening. It is important to book as we do not want to turn anyone away.
- ◆ Capacity is 16 places i.e. 1 person is one place, a family or a couple is one place. Sadly, we will be unable to allow people to stand in the aisles, at the back or in the Narthex
- ◆ The Church will open no earlier than 15 minutes before the start of Holy Mass
- ◆ You will be asked your name by the Steward, who will guide you to your place
- ◆ Holy Communion will be after the Final Blessing. Where we would normally say 'Amen' when receiving the Sacred Host, from now until we are told, we receive the Lord in silence
- ◆ Holy Communion will be distributed silently, with the communicant standing with outstretched arms and avoiding any physical contact

## **CHURCH OPENING - Private Prayer and Public Mass**

- ◆ Please wait in the pew until instructed to move forward to the Priest for Holy Communion by the Steward, taking into account the regulations on social distancing
- ◆ Straight after receiving the Sacred Host, please depart via the side door
- ◆ As you leave you will have an opportunity to put your envelopes or cash offerings in the basket. Alternatively, you can donate online or via standing order. See details below.
- ◆ The Church will then be closed for cleaning to take place ready for the next Mass

**Volunteers Needed** - In order to open the Church we need volunteers for every service. Without these volunteers, there will be no Public Masses

Stewards/Cleaners needed as follows:

Stewards: 20 minutes before the start of Mass on Tuesdays, Fridays and Sundays

Cleaners: 40 minutes straight after Mass on the above days

Ministers of the Word would also be very welcome, especially on Tuesdays. If you can help on a regular basis, we would love to hear from you asap. The next rota will start from the beginning of September.
