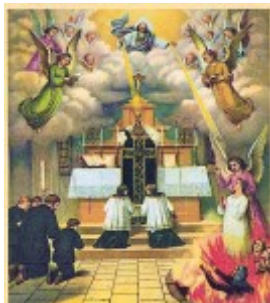

De Profundis

A prayer of a sinner, trusting in the mercies of God the sixth penitential psalm(129). Traditionally used to pray for the Holy Souls:



Out of the depths I have cried unto thee, O Lord; Lord, hear my voice. Let thine ears be attentive to the voice of my supplication. If thou, O Lord, shalt mark our iniquities: O Lord, who can abide it? For with thee there is mercy: and by reason of thy law I have waited on thee, O Lord. My soul hath waited on His Word: my soul hath hoped in the Lord. From the morning watch even unto night: let Israel hope in the Lord. For with the Lord there is mercy: and with him is plenteous redemption. And He shall redeem Israel from all his iniquities. Eternal rest give to them, O Lord and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen.

V. Lord, hear my prayer. **R.** And let my cry come unto thee.

Let us pray; O God, the creator and redeemer of all the faithful; grant to the souls of thy servants departed the remission of all their sins, that by our devout supplications they may obtain that pardon which they have always desired. Who livest and reignest world without end. Amen.
