Dear Friends

From the 19th July we are able to have a more open parish; this means that we can head back to a community, not only when it comes to the divine worship of the mysteries of Christ, but also of fraternity and friends. We will be able to have more people in church and a return to the things that we once enjoyed. This doesn't mean that we're going back to normal or how it was before, for many things have changed and are hard to bring back. Also, when it comes to evangelism we need fresh eyes on things and a new way of doing things, especially when it comes to the sacraments and the well-being of our people. We will look at that in September. The obligation for Holy Mass will be brought back at Advent and we will do some teaching on what the Sunday obligation means, keeping the sabbath day holy and the call of Christ to attendance on his day. We will also start Confessions and Adoration on Saturdays in September.

The wearing of face coverings is a protection for others. The Church urges us most strongly that face coverings continue to be worn during the course of celebrations, in accordance with the now well-established practice. But we also understand you have the freedom not to also. Please make sure that you have no symptoms before coming to Mass as you always have done and booking will only be required for the 10am Sunday Mass at the moment.

From next Sunday we will re-introduce congregational singing, and please note the continuing suspension, for the time being, of Communion under both kinds and the physical Sign of Peace. I will need one more Eucharistic Minister in addition to Deacon Rob to help with the distribution of Holy Communion at the moment.

The following measures continue:

- Sanitising hands on entering and exiting churches and before liturgies
- Strongly encouraging the continued use of face masks
- Ventilating buildings well
- Maintaining a good standard of church cleaning will carry on

Regarding the use of parish halls for social activities, it will be essential for us to continue to carry out risk assessments for events and activities, and to review the arrangements for the safe use of parish premises by private and commercial hirers. But please ask if you would like to hire the hall; it would be good to bring that back.

I think the new term is living with Covid and for us it's not a bother as we live with Christ.

CHURCH OPENING

Public Weekday Masses will be at 6.00pm on Mondays, Tuesdays and Fridays and also on Thursdays at 7.30pm in the Extraordinary Form (Latin)

The Vigil Masses will be at 6.00pm and the Sunday Masses at 8.00am (Latin) and 10am.

Booking required for Sunday 10am Mass only.

- To book your place, please email knaphill@abdiocese.org.uk or telephone 01483 472404, with the numbers attending; you should receive an email confirming your place in due course.
- Deadline for booking is 3.00pm on the Friday afternoon. It is important to book as we do not want to turn anyone away if capacity is reached.
- Unless you have booked, please do not come to the Church. Sad though it is, we will not be able to admit you to the Church as our capacity will have been reached and for the safety of those who have booked and for your own safety.
- In line with the guidance, face coverings should be worn in Church covering both the nose and mouth.
- Church will open 15 mins before Mass and will close after Mass for cleaning ready for the next Mass.
- If you have the 'Track and Trace' NHS Covid-19 app, please scan the QR code.
- We are unable to allow people to stand in the aisles, at the back or in the Narthex. You must not mix with anyone outside your household or support bubble indoors or outdoors. You should maintain strict social distancing at all times.

Whilst full guidelines are on display in the Narthex, please remember:

- Use the sanitiser provided as you enter and leave the Church and remember social distancing
- You will be guided to your place by the Steward and they will also instruct you when to move forward for Holy Communion
- Access to the Sacristy and Narthex will not be allowed
- Please note, good ventilation reduces the risks from airborne transmission and so windows will be open in the Church. Please put on an extra layer to keep warm!
- Do not mingle before or after Mass outside the Church. Please disperse immediately.


