**EASTER SUNDAY - 17TH APRIL 2022 YEAR C**

Dear Friends

At the great vigil of Easter we will hear the Exsultet, named after its first word "Exsultet" "Rejoice!" It is an ancient hymn of praise. Its origins are in the 4th and 5th centuries. The text has been written at some time between the 5th and 7th centuries. It was also, known as the Laus Cerei – the "praise for the candle" as it is a prayer of blessing, sung by a Deacon; thanks to Rob for his care in singing it. In the modern Roman Rite, we call it the Praeconium Paschale the "Easter proclamation". Its very purpose is to remind all Creation and Mother Church to raise a song of praise. This sung prayer recounts the wonders of the saving work of Christ, whose new and risen light, shining in the darkness, so the candle also represents our parish's praise in the Risen Lord; thank you Cath for your wonderful work in coming up with the design and painting it. The whole candle this year invokes us to pray for peace for the Ukraine and Russia. Again and again, the prayer tells of Christ's work, which comes to completion on this night of Easter, drawing much of its symbolism from the Old Testament. For "this is the night" when Christ paid Adam's debt to the eternal Father with his own blood. This is the night of the Passover, when Christ, the true Lamb, was slain to save Israel from slavery. This is the night when Christ, the pillar of fire, led his people through the Red Sea and the desert from slavery to freedom. This is the night when Adam's fault won for the world so great a redeemer, when God gave his own Son to ransom a slave. May this flame be found still burning by the Morning Star: the one Morning Star who never sets, Christ, especially in our parish in this coming year.

Thank you to all who have helped to make our celebrations of the Holy Week and Easter Liturgies an expression of our parish giving to God all our talents and offerings. Thanks to all the volunteers who have contributed generously to the Liturgies throughout Holy Week, and including the Masses on Easter Sunday! This includes welcomers, readers, musicians, florists, Altar servers, extraordinary ministers, counters, sacristans, cleaners and all who helped in the preparations for the Easter liturgies and Margo in the office. This week has truly deepened our faith that Jesus is truly risen, and having conquered death, invites us to share in His risen life. May the Easter Liturgy help us understand and appreciate more deeply the Paschal Mystery, the times of dying and rising to new life in Christ.

It is Good News that every Good Friday in our lives can be transformed into an Easter Sunday. No pain, no sorrow, not even death itself, need defeat us: all is made new in the Risen Christ.

May Deacon Rob and myself wish you all, our parishioners and friends,  
a very happy and blessed Easter.
