EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Friends,

Thank you for all the kind wishes and prayers over my little bout of Covid and I'm still feeling tired; please pray for others in the parish who have Covid and some who are in the hospital.

My last Mass before I go to the community in York will be on Monday 15th August (Latin Mass) at 9am for the Assumption of our Lady, followed by a lite breakfast. I will be back at the end of September to pack my things and have a farewell Rosary and party on Friday 30th September. After August 14th, the weekly schedule will be Saturday Vigil Mass at 6pm, Sunday at 8am (Latin) and the 9.30am Mass. With great sadness, the 11.30am Sunday and weekday Masses will be suspended for the time being while Fathers Rob and Nick and Deacon Rob work out what is best for our parish.



We also pray for the Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes, which has started this weekend and for pilgrims and helpers from our parish; that the shrine Our Lady of Lourdes will be an inspiration to those who are called to be in our Mother Mary's presence and that she will infuse them with the love of Christ, her Son, and help us by their pilgrim prayers, which are so powerful to God. The month of July is dedicated to Precious Blood of Jesus

The month of the Precious Blood of Jesus beautifully flows forth from the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. As the side of Christ was pierced with a lance, out gushed blood and water, from which (as the early Fathers say) came the birth of the Church and the Holy Sacraments. Indeed, it is also by the shedding of the Spotless Lamb's blood that our sins are forgiven and our redemption purchased. Every single drop of the Precious Blood contains in it the entirety of the Life and Love of God; His very Self is fully contained in a single droplet from the Precious Chalice.

A short prayer "Praised be Your Precious Blood, O Jesus Christ, which, continually pouring forth from Your side, saves us!"
