## **NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

Dear Friends,

It is a traditional custom for people to bring fresh herbs and Cut flowers to church to be blessed on the Solemnity of the Assumption. If you have herbs in your garden, be sure to cut some and bring them for a special blessing! The blessing of the herbs will take place at all Masses next weekend. Place your herbs by the Lady Altar. There will also be other herbs for you to take home and add to your food or drinks as part of your celebration of the Assumption of our Blessed Virgin Mary at home. Also on Sunday the 14th at 8pm, we will have a candlelight procession with Holy Rosary; please join us. Then on Monday the 15th, there will be Mass (Latin) at 9am followed by a "bring and share" breakfast.

As from the 16th, there will be no weekday Adoration or Masses until the priests start in September, it would be a wonderful act of love to have a time of prayer with Adoration and the Rosary or the Liturgy of Hours led by our community, with the help of Deacon Rob.
